If you would like to present a research paper/thesis or a presentation, please submit your proposal, no later than **March 10, 2024**.

- Send an electronic version of the paper including: file name, first and last name of the author in Latin (English) letters (e.g. Smith.doc) to this address: conference.ihud@gmail.com by **March 10, 2024**.

As our conference is available in French, English and Russian languages, to facilitate accurate translation, please send *a summary* (maximum of 4 pages using A4 format or US Letter size 8.5 by 11 inches) of your presentation, paper, speech or any voiceover texts included in videos. This ensures efficient translation and enhances accessibility for all participants.

Please note that during the conference your materials can be presented in different formats: slide shows, video clips and videos with comments and screenings, and individual and group performances of teachers and students.

The structure of both the speech or presentation should contain the following elements:

- formulation of the problem and justification of its relevance
- clear definition of the article's aim and objectives
- designation of the purpose and objectives of the presentation, the paper or the speech
- presentation of the main material with analytical substantiation of scientific research on which the author relies
- conclusions, recommendations, prospects for further research
- list of sources used

Further Guidelines for Research Papers or Presentations for IHUD CH Conference

Submission deadline: March 10, 2024

The purpose of the **5th International Scientific E-Conference** is to consolidate the efforts of scientists and specialists in the field of integral methodology and methodological synthesis aimed at identifying the unity of society, the formation of a stable environment for the harmonious development of Humanity in a single socio-cultural space.

Please read the following information carefully before you submit your proposal.

Membership

You **do not** have to be a member of IHUD CH at the time you submit a proposal; however, if your submission is selected for presentation, we encourage you to consider joining our team in the future.

Submission Process

All applicants, scientists, researchers, scholars, educators, and others are encouraged to submit their proposals online by **March 10, 2024**, in the correct format. Confirmation of receipt will be e-mailed within 48 hours. Presenters then will be notified by email of the Conference Organizing Committee's decision of their acceptance.

The Proposal

All proposals must be submitted in English and in a publishable format: Microsoft Office Word 98, 2003, or later. Font: Times New Roman, font size – 14 PT, spacing – 1.5 PT. Margins: left – 30 mm, right – 15 mm, top and bottom – 20 mm. **Page numbering should not be assigned.** All proposals should be written in third person format avoiding the use of “I”, “you” and “we.” Our Editing and Content Department reviews each submission and makes grammatical suggestions if necessary.

The order of material placement

In the upper right-hand corner, please state the author's (or authors') last name, initials, position, place of work, academic rank, and scientific degree. The article title should be stated in capital letters in the centre of the page. Please include an abstract (3-4 sentences) one interval of space below the title, including keywords, followed by the text of the article. Use APA style for in-text citations. One interval of space below the body of the article, provide a list of sources used in alphabetical order without numbering under the heading REFERENCES.

APA style uses the author's last name and year of publication, for example: (Field, 2005). For direct quotations, include the page number as well, for example: (Field, 2005, p. 14). For sources such as websites and e-books that do not indicate page numbers, state the paragraph number. More information on citing sources without pagination is available on the APA Style web page: <https://apastyle.apa.org>

Example of a paragraph with in-text citation:

“... A few researchers in the linguistics field have developed training programs designed to improve native speakers' abilities to understand an accented speech (Derwing, Rossiter, & Munro, 2002; Thomas, 2004). Their training techniques are based on the research described above indicating that comprehension improves with exposure to non-native speech. Derwing and co-authors (2002) conducted their training with students preparing to be social workers, but noted that other professionals who work with non-native speakers, could also benefit from a similar program.”

Materials that do not meet the stated requirements, the level of the conference and/or submitted after the deadline will not be considered nor returned. Submitted presentations are not subject to editing and shall constitute the original material for further replication purposes.

You will be asked to provide the following information when completing the submission.

Title

Type the title in English. The title should be in capitals. If you use acronyms, please spell out the words first and place the acronym in parentheses following the words.

Presentation Types: You must submit to one of the following formats:

- **Session** – a session presentation will be maximum 25 minutes in length with 5 minutes of questions and answers where applicable. *If you need more time, please contact the conference organising team.* It may have a single presenter or co-presenters and should address the Conference topic **Science and Education in the Formation of an Integral Worldview as an Evolutionary Necessity** in an engaging and interactive format. It is important that time limits are respected as the Organizing Committee assigns the Conference schedule.
- **Research-oriented Paper** – A research-oriented paper presentation is 25 minutes in length with 5 minutes allotted for questions and answers where applicable. *If you need more time, please contact the conference organising team.* Proposals should address a current and relevant research topic of interest on Conference topics. Presentations might include a brief introduction about the focus or question of the study, subjects, research design and analysis, but the vast amount of time should be spent on results and implications for integrative methodologies. Presenters should avoid reading papers and/or study results, and instead present the research in an appealing form.
- **Roundtable** – A roundtable discussion of 45 minutes with specific questions will follow at the conclusion of the conference. Roundtables are an ideal format for networking and in-depth discussion.

Audience Level

Please note that our Conference is composed of a diversified audience of scientists, researchers, academics, scholars, teachers, parents, students, and interested others.

Content and Purpose of the Proposal

The content and purpose must be in English and should give insight as to the relevance of your proposal. It should be clear, specific, and detailed. It should show originality and provide new insight into the topic based on current practices. The content and purpose must clearly align with the keyword and audience level. What you write in this section is for review purposes only by the Conference Organizing Committee. **What will your presentation focus on and what new insights will it provide?**

Strategies for Engagement

The strategies for engagement section only applies to the speakers on how your information will be shared with the audience that can be interactive. **How will you actively engage participants as part of your presentation?**

Review Process: The IHUD CH Conference Organising Committee will be responsible for reviewing all proposals submitted. English, French or Russian language submissions will be reviewed by a team of experts in that language. Finally, the number of proposals that can be accepted for the conference are based on the meeting schedule and time allocation.
